#### WHAT

This global project will strengthen the institutional and technical capacities of developing countries to collect, analyse and disseminate forest-related data.

The project will support countries in meeting the Enhanced Transparency Framework (ETF) requirements of the Paris Agreement and contribute with information necessary to track progress made in implementing and achieving the Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs).

### **WHO**

The FAO will implement the project, through its <u>Global Forest</u> <u>Resources Assessment</u> (FRA) and <u>National Forest Monitoring</u> (NFM) teams, working closely with national institutions.

#### **HOW**

- ✓ By ensuring that relevant national institutions responsible for forest-related data are able to report and respond to the transparency requirements to improved institutional capacity;
- ✓ By enhancing technical capacity of governmental counterparts in pilot countries in reporting, accuracy and consistency of forest-related data;
- ✓ By increasing knowledge sharing among transparency practitioners and experts.

#### **IMPACT**

The project will directly benefit 26 targeted countries and more broadly some 187 countries and territories that are part of the global network of National Correspondents for the Global Forest Resources Assessment.


## Main global outputs



- ➤ Upgrading FAO's Global Forest Resources Assessment <u>reporting</u> platform (#FRA2020).
- Developing an e-learning course "Forests and Transparency under the Paris Agreement" in English, Spanish and French (FAO e-learning Centre).




## Main global outputs



- ➤ Organizing sub-regional and national workshops across Asia, Africa and Latin America and the Caribbean to build countries' and sub-regions' capacities
- ➤ Identifying and sharing case studies and best practices on transparency in the forest sector: first one Costa Rica, upcoming DRC and Bangladesh.
- Developing a series of outreach and communication materials (tool kit).







## Planned activities with pilot countries



- Explore the use of institutional platforms of FAO (FRA reporting platform, <u>Food and Agriculture</u> <u>Microdata Catalogue</u>, FAM) under the GFFOR output.
- Carry out an assessment of needs and gaps through a defined process and methodology, using an excel tool based on the Voluntary Guidelines on National Forest Monitoring (VGNFM)
- Define a **roadmap** and implement capacitybuilding activities.
