HEALTH SECTOR :- NEWLY CONSTRUCTED PLACENTA PIT OF MORULINGA HEALTH CENTER II.

1. INTRODUCTION

Morulinga Health center ii, Lack of a placenta pit has been one of the major challenge in maintaining deliveries in the health center. This has been reported several times by the CBMES through the management of CAA to the sub-county and the District.

This Issue among others was also presented at sub-county and district dialogues of F/Y 2017/18, it was also noted by the HUMC and health center staffs as one of the in completed priorities of last year and therefore presented again at the district dialogue held on 21st of June 2019.

2. THE NEW PLACENTA PIT.

During the recent follow up visit Made on the 5th of July 2019, conducted, it was found that the health center had already received the BOQs of the placenta pit and the construction had already started.

Due to the UDN capacity building support, we are now able to influence decision makers to take community concerns as major priorities in planning and implementation of programs.

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ROAD SECTOR:- LOTEDEDE – LOMALIGA ACCESS ROAD NAPAK

1. INTRODUCTION

Opening of Loteede-Lomaliga access road was pronounced by the former sub-county chief of Lopeei sub-county Mr. TEKO JOSEPH during the ECD (Early child hood Development) Advocacy meeting held at Lopeei T.C market ground in April 2017 before his transfer.

The community waited for the road until the transfer of the above chief when the road was nowhere to be seen. However, Community based Monitors of Lopeei sub-county fore lead by Paul Koriang who acts as a coordinator CAA in the district kept following up and demanded for the road while making it one of the major issues at dialogue papers and other community Barrazas related to service delivery.



A 12 Km Loteede – Lomaliga road opened and only requires Marraming and putting culverts.

In the F/Y 2018/19, it was noted that the road was therefore taken as one of the major priority among other activities at a cost of 8.5 Million shillings.

During a monitoring visit conducted on 12th of April 2019, a 12 Km by 5.5 road was being opened from Loteede to Lomaliga and the UDN community based monitors kept on

tracking the progress until it was completed by mid of May 2019.

The road has currently helped Loteede community in Lopeei sub-county to access Kango-le Market with their goods and services hence improving livelihoods of people through businesses.

It has also linked the community of Lomaliga to Moroto – Kotido road and any service provider can easily access them compared to the past situation.

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
